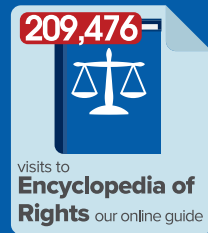
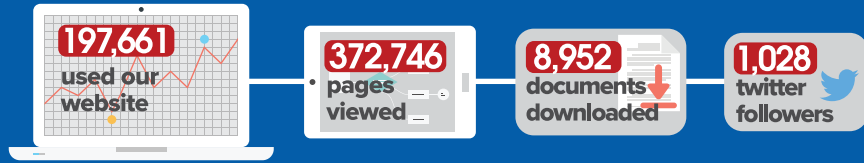

“Social Justice in Action”

The pace of change both internally and externally continued to accelerate in this last year with staffing and funding impacts for Law Centre NI. We were delighted to welcome Glenn Jordan as our new Director, as well as our new Assistant Director for Organisational Services, Andrew McCracken. We are also grateful to Ursula O’Hare who served as Acting Director during the transition period.

We are hugely proud of all our **staff** and **volunteers** and their consistent **commitment to social justice**. This year they have worked with victims of trafficking and forced labour, ensured people with mental health problems could live more independently, helped many vulnerable people get their benefit entitlements, supported relatives in ensuring that long-term patients were not charged for care they cannot afford, and strengthened the protection of workers.

In addition we have played a key role alongside partner organisations in supporting the families who arrived in Northern Ireland as part of the Syrian Vulnerable Persons Relocation Scheme. And we helped shape law, policy and practice in all the areas of our expertise.

There will be no lessening of the pace this year but be in no doubt that we will continue to advocate for a more just society. We will also work constructively with our partners in the Northern Ireland Advice Services Consortium for the benefit of our clients.

Finally, we are grateful to those funders who have continued to support the work of the Law Centre. We also thank our many members, partner organisations and individuals who signpost to us, visit us, rely on us, check out our website and generally keep us busy and motivated. We look forward to working with you and for you again in the coming year.

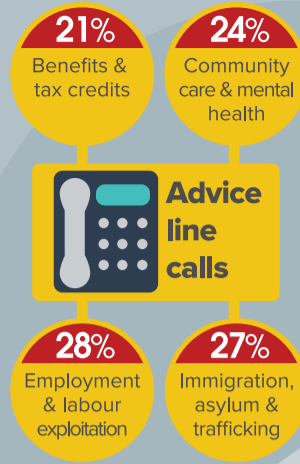

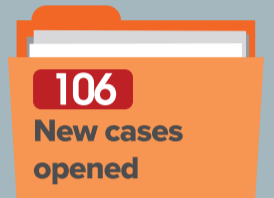

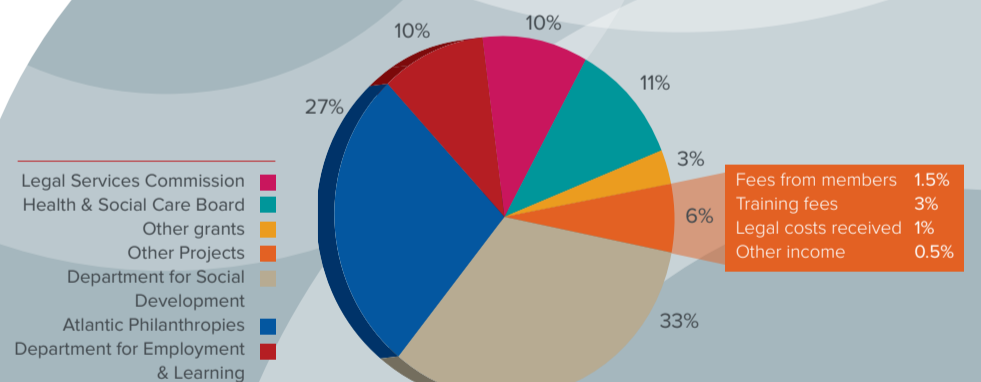

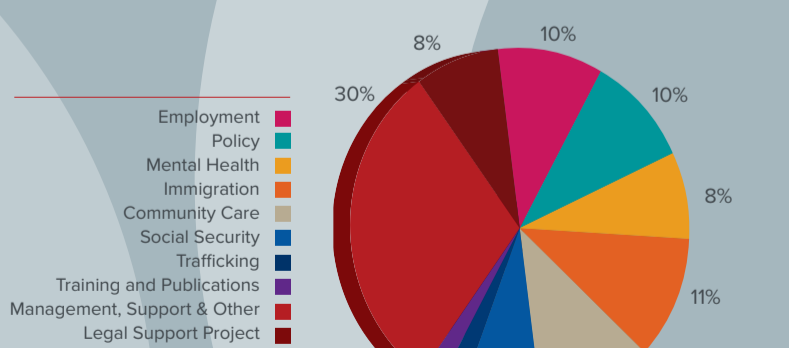
